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Required Documentation to Bill SLP at the Professional Level

As of September 1, 2015 the clinical licensing of Speech Language Pathologists transferred from the VT Agency of Education to the VT Secretary of State's office. The Educational Speech Language Pathologist license (endorsement 6-84) will still be issued by the VT Agency of Education.

This raises the question of what licensure or credentials is the supervisory union/school district required to have on file to verify an SLP can be billed as a professional. There are now three items that will serve to support an SLP's CCC professional status

1. A current or expired Certificate of Clinical Competence from the American Speech and Hearing Association
2. A State of Vermont Clinical SLP/Audiologist License AND proof of the completion of a Clinical Fellowship year (Speech-Language Pathology Clinical Fellowship Report and Rating Form)
 - A limited scope, limited duration State of Vermont Clinical SLP/Audiologist License can be substituted as proof of Clinical Fellowship year.
3. An Educational Speech Language Pathologist License (endorsement 6-84) AND proof of the completion of a Clinical Fellowship year (Speech-Language Pathology Clinical Fellowship Report and Rating Form)
4. A Provisional Educational Speech Language Pathologist license (endorsement 6-84)
 - A Provisional Educational Speech Language Pathologist License is issued when an individual has met all requirements but is in the process of completing their Clinical Fellowship year
