INSTRUCTIONAL LEVELS

The Agency of Education issues educator licenses. Licenses include two codes. The first code is the instructional level. The second two-digit code is the endorsement. The following endorsement codes are considered professional providers for Developmental and Assistive Therapy and Case Management: 67, 68, 80, 81, 82, 84, 85, 86, 87

The following are the instructional levels:

0 Birth through Grade 3	8 Grades K-8
1 Grades K-6	9 Grades 5-12
2 Grades 7-12	10 Grades 7 through age 21
3 Grades PreK-12	11 Grades 9 through 12
4 Grades 5-9	12 Grades K through age 21
5 Birth through age 6	13 Grades 8 through age 21
6 Age 3 through age 21	14 Grades K - 3
7 Grades PreK through 6	15 Birth through Old Age
